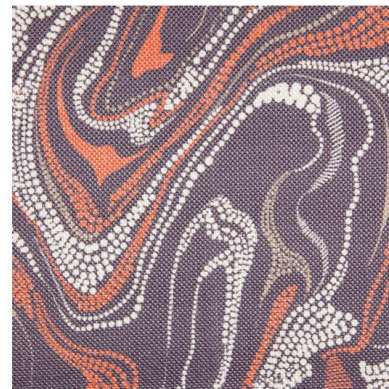
Inspiration was on display at BDNV with these products

At this year's BDNV show in New York City, designers and companies showcased their latest and greatest. With location, sustainability and nature in mind, these products feature modern innovations with inspirational touches.

A / Designer Laura Kirar's playfully theatrical natural lampmakeray rope is woven into palm forms as seen with the Mar Chandider for **Arteriors**, which calls to mind the classic era of the 1930s in the coastal south of France. Held together by an iron rod finished in antique brass, Kirar pays homage to the details of casually curated Mediterranean interiors with their influences of aged formal furniture; the micro-climate combinations of tropical plants and pines; and the passion for all things exotic from carved Spanish vergueta to primitive and sculptural African chairs. **B / Shaw Contract** has launched ROAM, a new line of broadloom and carpet tile designed specifically for the hospitality market. The ROAM series of custom collections is reflective of the destinations where designer projects come to life. The first selection from the series, ROAM Painted Desert, features designs influenced by the desert landscape of the North American Southwest. It is rich in color and texture with a variety of patterns, scales and constructions to bring the feel of the desert landscape to life. ROAM was designed by the Shaw Contract Hospitality design team in conjunction with custom designers from its StudioOne program. Typically, the design team from StudioOne is focused on designing for specific custom projects, but the two groups collaborated on a location focus for the collection and then developed artwork and mood boards around the concept of a hospitality setting and overall destination in the Southwest. **C / SWFL**, which is a transitional pattern and comes in five colorways, is one of **Cortex Fabrics**' silicone offerings, which is a sustainable, performance upholstery product. It is essentially sand, which is processed into organic silicone monomer and silicone polymer. Silicone will meet and exceed all industry standards for coated fabrics/upholstery for ASTM, ISO, ACT and CFFA. It is often referred to as Vegan leather. **D /** The Ocean Master M1 Cupola from **Tuedi** features an elevated vent that facilitates a continual breeze beneath the canopy. With a sea-scoop valance, the cupola maximizes comfort while embracing traditional Mediterranean style. To further tailor the design with striking color and pattern combinations, enhancements such as double-sided canopies and accent binding are available on both the square and hexagon-shaped parasols. Like all shade structures in the Ocean Master M1 Collection, the new design features a polished aluminum hub system and reinforced rib joints that provide added strength and reliability, even in strenuous weather conditions. The cupola is available in 14 finishes including rich Aluma-Teak wood tones, neutral powder coat hues and the flagship polished titanium.
